



ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF COUNSELOR EDUCATION, REHABILITATION COUNSELING

Responsibilities

- Teach graduate courses in both rehabilitation education and general counselor education curriculum
- Develop and pursue a sustained research agenda resulting in publications and external funding
- Participate in program initiatives, advising and faculty decisions

Minimum Qualifications

- Earned doctorate in Rehabilitation Counselor/Counselor Education, or a closely-related field which meets Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) requirements for core faculty (or which meets grandfather provisions for existing rehabilitation counseling faculty or recent graduates: <http://www.cacrep.org/wp-content/uploads/2012/10/FAQs-on-doctoral-level-Rehabilitation-Counselor-Education-accreditation-10.22.15.pdf>)
- Knowledge, skills, and training in Rehabilitation Counseling curriculum and ability to provide clinical supervision to Master's and Doctoral students;
- Experience and/or ability to teach campus and distance courses.
- Certification or eligibility for Certified Rehabilitation Counselor (CRC)

Preferred Qualifications

- A record of research productivity
- Work experience in rehabilitation counseling, clinical rehabilitation counseling or clinical setting offering services for individuals with disabilities
- Experience teaching as a faculty member, graduate teaching assistant, or doctoral intern within a counselor education program
- Licensure as Professional Counselor and/or National Certified Counselor, NCC

The review of credentials will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Starting date is August 16, 2019. Benefits include health and life insurance, TIAA-CREF available, Teachers' Retirement System of Alabama, and summer employment available on an as needed basis.
